Online Experience for High Risk Groups

SOCIAL DISTANCING

To keep with the government's social distancing guidelines:

4real will not be offering before service hang-out time or pizza prior to the worship experience, until further notice. Please make sure that your student eats before they come and that they do not arrive before 7p.

While in the auditorium, students will be meeting in groups of 10, maintaining 6 feet of distance between each group. Large and small group time will both be held in the auditorium providing ample space for students to safely engage in the service and enjoy some friendly, team competition!

MASKS All 4Real Impact TEAM members will be encouraged to wear masks following our state guidelines for this phase. It is recommended for students but will not be enforced.

CHECK-IN Students will park in the main parking lot and check-in at the main doors. The 4real Guest Services team will be conducting *temperature checks and will print out the student's security badges for them, allowing the students to have a touch-free experience.

***TEMPERATURE** All serving team members, and students will have their temperature taken upon check-in. If anyone has a temperature over 100.4, they will not be able to participate. Parents of students who don't drive will be contacted to pick up their student.

HAND SANITIZING stations will be strategically placed near all entrances, exits, and in common areas. These will be routinely monitored throughout gatherings to ensure they are always full of product. All stations will contain a product that meets the minimum requirements of 60% alcohol

by volume, the amount suggested by the CDC as the minimum amount necessary to be effective against viruses.

SICKNESS Should your student become sick while in service, we will notify you to come and get them so that others are not exposed.

Should a student attending a 4Real service contract the Coronavirus, a notification will be sent out immediately to all families.

CLEANING All hard surfaces in the 4Real environments will be sanitized before the service with a disinfectant solution approved by the PA Department of Health. Restrooms will receive a thorough cleaning as well as a once over during the service.

Our HVAC system hosts mechanical ductwork called Plasma Air, an ionization system that kills viruses and cleans the air during the return air portion of the system and has been confirmed to kill the Coronavirus. The air will be cleaned 4 or 5 times per hour and will help keep our attendees safe.

CHECK OUT Parents will enter the drive-in pick up line at the front of the HUB. Safety Team will ask for the student's name(s). Once the students are called, they will meet all guardians at their cars, at the back of the HUB as per normal.
