Online Experience for High Risk Groups

Based on currently available information and clinical expertise, anyone who has serious underlying medical conditions might be at higher risk for severe illness from COVID-19. Anyone with an underlying health condition, running a fever or are experiencing any of the COVID-19 symptoms should stay home (children and adults). We will continue to offer an online experience for all who are not able to return during this phase. On-Campus Experience

All kids will be **moving up** to their new, age-appropriate worship experiences.

MASKS All Believers Kids Impact TEAM members will be encouraged to wear masks following our state guidelines for this phase. It is also recommended for children above the age of 3; however, we are leaving this up to your discretion as the primary caregiver of your child.

Additionally, all of our cleaning staff will wear appropriate gloves and masks while conducting their cleaning duties throughout the day in an attempt to further reduce the chance of transmission.

ONLINE CHECK-IN is completely touch-free! Every week you will register online at www.believerschurch.org, at the bottom of the homepage, look for **KIDS RSVP**. Simply fill out the form and we will have your badges printed and ready for you when you arrive on Sunday. Registration will be open from Sunday - Saturday for the Sunday following. Don't forget, when RSVPing your child, to move them up to the next grade (kindergarten - 5th grade only).

When you arrive on-campus, park in the front parking lot and head toward the main entrance. There you will see a big blue tent that says "BK check-in." Following CDC guidelines, a BK Guest Services team member will check your child's temperature* and then you will receive your printed badges.

Champions Club Families, you will park in the Champs parking spaces near the playground. When you arrive at the double doors, show your Champs key fob to the Champs team member and they will check-in your whole family.

DIAPER BAGS AND BACKPACKS

Please leave your child's diaper bag, backpack and/or car seat in the car.

Should your Preschooler need a diaper or your baby needs a bottle, we will have a bin with your child's name on it to place their necessary items in.

***TEMPERATURE** All serving team members, and kids will have their temperature taken at check-in. If anyone has a temperature over 100.4, they will not be able to participate and will need to enjoy worship from home.

YOU'RE INSIDE, NOW WHAT? Following government guidelines, churches in the state of VA are able to operate at 50% of their capacity during this phase. To accomplish this, our small group ratios have been decreased to accommodate 6 feet of distance between each child as much as possible. Our age-appropriate large group experience will be held in our small group environments in order to keep the intermingling to a minimum. Please check the monitors before entering to make sure your child is in his/her new age-appropriate environment.

There will be one entrance and one exit into the Believers Kids space. We ask that only 1-2 family members accompany the children upon drop-off. Thank you in advance for going with the flow!

SNACKS

No snacks will be provided in BK with the exception of bottles for infants and a limited one time selection of individually wrapped items for children who are attending multiple services.

HAND SANITIZING stations will be strategically placed near all entrances, exits, and in common areas. These will be routinely monitored throughout gatherings to ensure they are always full of product. All stations will contain a product that meets the minimum requirements of 60% alcohol by volume, the amount suggested by the CDC as the minimum amount necessary to be effective against viruses.

SICKNESS Should your child become sick while in service, we will notify you to come and get them. Once they are picked up, we ask that you do not take them into the adult worship experience with you, but care for them at home to keep others from being exposed.

Should a child attending a service have contact with someone who has contracted the Coronavirus, a notification will be sent out immediately to all families of the children exposed.

CHECK OUT all Believers kids will be picked up in the rooms they were dropped off in and following the designated flow of traffic to exit.

CLEANING All hard surfaces in the Believers Kids environments will be sanitized after each service with a disinfectant solution approved by the PA Department of Health. Restrooms will receive a thorough cleaning in between services as well as a once over during each service.

Our HVAC system hosts mechanical ductwork called Plasma Air, an ionization system that kills viruses and cleans the air during the return air portion of the system and has been confirmed to kill the Coronavirus. The air will be cleaned 4 or 5 times per hour and will help keep our families safe.
